
Season Quest 5 (July): Look Back

Quest Brief 5

Hello WROboticists of Singapore!

The competition dates draw closer, and what better time to look back at your journey in WRO 2026? Throughout your journey in WRO, you've been met with many different challenges that test you as Roboticists in many areas. You would have noticed every Season Quest has a reflection portion to fill out. Hence, for this final Season Quest, you will be doing an overall reflection of your journey in WRO 2026!

1. Use the same Instagram account that you have set up for your team for the previous Season Quests.
2. Put up an Instagram Post in the Carousel format with the following images:
 - a. *Team photo*: This should be a different team photo from your Season Quest 1 team photo. It can be a photo of your Team during training, attempting the missions, having a discussion or just simply having fun.
 - b. *Note*: Teams concerned about privacy may consider using Profile Portraits (side view), environmental portraits, masked photos etc. and do not have to be headshots.
3. Accompany the Post with the following caption:
 - a. Content:
 - i. *Reflecting on team's goals*: Looking back at the first goal you set in Season Quest 1, did your team achieve it? (E.g completing 50% of the missions) If your goal is to win specific awards, what steps has your team taken to get closer to achieving that goal? It can be simple routine of attending every training session, having team reflections regularly or simply the team's determination.
 - ii. *Reflecting on challenges faced*: What major challenges did your team face during the WRO 2026 season? Consider aspects like teamwork, limited knowledge and skills in building or programming, time management, or any other difficulties your team encountered. Tell us about how these challenges have impacted your team!
 - iii. *Reflecting on actions made*: As a team, you were met with many different challenges, tell us what actions were made to overcome such challenges? If your team did not try to solve these challenges, tell us what could your team have done to solve it?
 - iv. *Special Recognition*: Teams can mention people who helped them in their journey in WRO 2026 season. It can be parents, teachers, coaches or their friends. Tell us how they have contributed to the team's journey or success.
 - b. Hashtag: Use the Hashtags #wrosingapore26, #augustseasonquest, and #AimForTheStars so that we (and others) can find you easily. Feel free to use other appropriate Hashtags to boost the visibility of your Team.

- c. Tags: Tag us at @wro_singapore and @spacefacultyasia. If your Robotics Club or school has an Instagram Account, feel free to tag them too. If you are looking for specific Companies or Organisations to sponsor or mentor your team, it will be a good opportunity to catch their attention by tagging them as well. Together, we can connect our Robotics community, learn from each other, and have fun together through the WRO experience.
- 4. Submission:
 - a. Put up the Post on Instagram
 - b. Fill up the following table and [submit via this link](#).
 - c. For teachers who are submitting their teams' posts in bulk, please kindly use the link above as well.
 - d. Successful Submission for this Season Quest entails fulfilling the criteria set out above while following the general guidelines posed in the General Brief. In doing so, your team will be awarded *4% of the Qualifying Score*.
 - e. **Submission is to be done by 4th September**. Late submissions will not qualify for any points.
