“It is not whether you win or lose, but how much you learn that counts.”

As a team we follow these principles:

We are participating in a competition.
We like to win. We want to learn.
And we also want to have fun.

We want to play fair.
We design our own robot and we write our own software.
It is not fair if someone else does that for us.

We can only learn if we try things ourselves.
Our coach can teach us things and guide us.
And we can also get inspired by others.

But our coach should not do the work for us.
And we do not simply copy a robot, a solution or software from someone else.
We use the examples we find to design our own robot and our program.

Sometimes we fail and that is OK.
Original ideas come from failing.
Winning is nice but failing is part of our journey.
